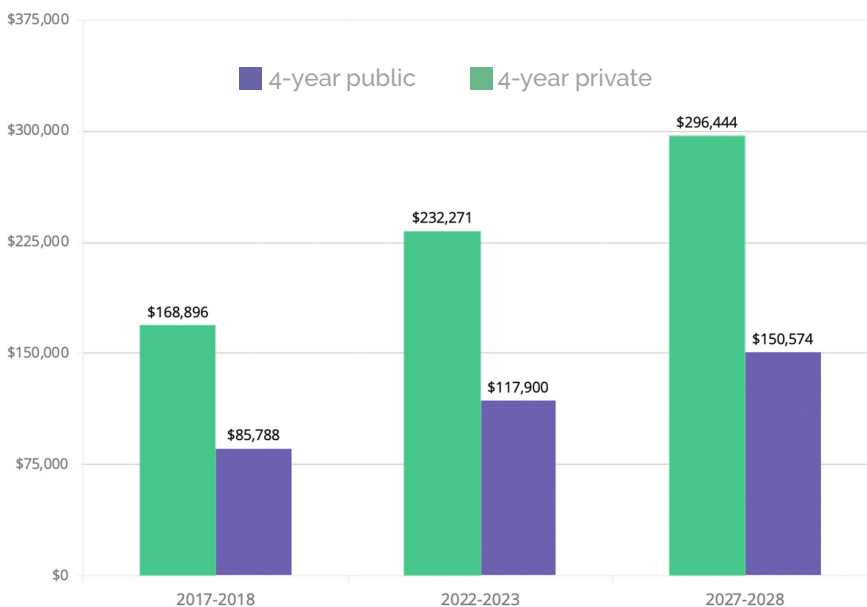
Facts about higher education

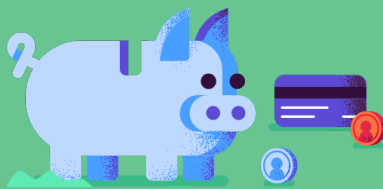
